







UNIFORM WEARING & CARE

ITEM	HOW TO WEAR	CARE
WEDGE 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Worn on the right side of the head, centred front and back, with the front edge of the cap 2.5 cm above the right eyebrow.• Worn at all times in uniform except when eating, when in an eating establishment, or when in a place of worship.• May also be removed while in transportation but must be replaced before exiting the vehicle.• Headdress is also customarily removed when seated in class.	Dry clean only No iron
DRESS SHIRT 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Buttoned to top when worn with tie.• Open neck when worn without tie.• Worn with tie with or without jacket or open neck without jacket and rank slip-ons shall be worn with the shirt.	Machine Washable Dryer safe Iron medium heat
T-SHIRT 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Free of wrinkles.• Worn with C3 dress• Worn under flight suit	Machine Washable Dryer safe Iron on low heat
TIE 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Usually worn with dress shirt and tunic• Full Windsor knot kept tight• Extending to middle of belt pants belt buckle <p data-bbox="829 1829 1187 1856"><i>See how to tie a Windsor knot</i></p>	Dry clean only No iron

JACKET (tunic)



- Shall always be fully buttoned, except the top button.
- Shall be kept clean and wrinkle-free.
- The sleeves of the jacket shall have no creases.
- The buckle shall be centered on the uniform.
- Nothing is to be carried in the tunic pockets.
- All pocket flaps shall be buttoned at all times.

Machine Washable
Dryer safe
Iron on low heat
No creases
Hang to store

TROUSERS



- Clean and pressed
- Length extending to third boot lace eyelet
- Nothing visible in pockets

Machine Washable
Dryer safe
Iron on low heat
Creases down front and back centre of each leg
Hang to store

BELT



- Always worn with trousers
- Buckle centred with trousers
- Nickel end meeting nickel buckle

Hand wash
Air Dry

SOCKS



- Worn with cadet boots
- Not rolled down

Machine Washable
Dryer safe

BOOTS



- Clean and highly shone
- Horizontally laced

**PARKA
OUTER
SHELL**



- worn year round when weather conditions dictate;
- the liner and the exterior coat may be worn separately or as a set;
- zipper and dome fasteners shall be fully closed to the second from the top button
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Machine Washable
Air dry

**PARKA
INNER
FLEECE
LINER**



- May be worn without outer parka shell.
- Liner alone shall not be worn for ceremonial events in public.

Dryer safe

TOQUE



- Worn as an alternative winter headdress.
- Insignia is centered directly over the nose.

Dryer safe

GLOVES



- Worn when ordered or as required during winter dress.

Machine Washable
Air dry

**RANK
SLIP-ONS**



- Shall be worn on the epaulettes of both shoulders on the most outer layer of dress shirt, the parka liner or parka shell.

Machine Washable
Air dry
Iron on low heat
